What is stewardship?

Stewardship is God's blessings flowing through us. Prayer, generosity, and participation are the ways we allow God's blessing to flow through us.

What is tithing?

Biblically, a "tithe" was a 1/10th portion of livestock or crops that landowners gave to Levites, priests, and the poor-- non-land owners that couldn't feed themselves. We answer this call to give in a similar way today to pay for the on-going costs of running a church and outreach to the poor including masses, baptisms, funerals, weddings, ministries, staff, utilities, and more. The Catholic recommendation is to give 5% of your household income to your local parish, 1% to your local archdiocese, and 4% to charities of your choice.
