How will my child be rostered in a class at HTEEC?

Typically, we have two classes per age group at HTEEC. Meeting times and program offerings of each classroom may vary.

For Extended Day and Early Pick Up programs, students are primarily placed in a classroom by when they are eligible for Kindergarten (turns 5 on or before August 31st). This way, all students in a classroom will be in a cohort that, hypothetically, will all attend Kindergarten at the same time. Other considerations can play a part in classroom placement; more information is outlined in the parent handbook, available once enrollment is confirmed.

What other requirements are there for enrollment at HTEEC?

HTEEC is licensed by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE). As a result, all parents must comply with any KDHE requirements for program enrollment including, but not limited to, completing required enrollment paperwork.

HTEEC falls under the administrative jurisdiction of the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas and Holy Trinity Catholic Parish. Parents must comply with Archdiocesan VIRTUS requirements.
